# Email Connect Features

## Ultimate User Experience for Scan to Email.

### ▶ Integrated Scan to Email\*

- Microsoft® Exchange Server (on premise)
- Microsoft Exchange Online/Office365®
- Gmail™ Webmail Service – No SMTP relay server is required

### ▶ Security and Convenience


- Scan and send emails from logged in users
- Access to your contact list (Global and Personal)
- Sent history in the Outlook® or Gmail clients
- Applies Exchange server rules and security (e.g. size limit, destination restrictions)
- Single Sign On (SSO)

# Integrated Scan to Gmail


Along with the “Scan to Google Drive” feature, direct Gmail integration from Sharp is an ideal solution for growing Google for Work/Education environments.



*\*User authentication is enabled, users require to login for the first time. The MFP establishes single-sign-on (SSO) with OAuth token for next time.*

# Integrated Scan to Exchange Email (1)


**Security and convenience:** Email will be sent by logged in users. All sent emails are stored on the sent item folder. All rules and policies set at the Exchange server will be applied for greater control.




*\*For on-premise Exchange, when Active Directory user authentication is enabled, the MFP establishes Kerberos token-based single-sign-on. The manual login is not required. When LDAP or Local authentication is used, users require to login for the first time. The credentials are encrypted and stored on the MFP to establish SSO for the next time. When the password is changed, the manual login screen will be presented. For Office365, SSO can be established by storing user credentials (optional).*

  - Exchange On-premise
  - Exchange Online (Office 365)



